

Vase of Roses

Attach parchment to pattern using low tack tape.

TRACE:

Trace the outside boarder in white pencil or ink. Trace the Design in black ink or fine liner.

EMBOSS:

Micro/Small ball tool = Emboss the roses, leaves and ribbon of the design. Also emboss the outside boarder lines. Don't worry about embossing the vase unless you have decided not to do it as a 3-D element, in which case; emboss detail as you wish.

COLOUR:

Using pencils in colours of you choice colour the flowers, leaves and ribbon on the back of the parchment.

PERFORATE & CUT:

Perforate the area marked 'P' on the pattern using a grid and bold single needle tool.

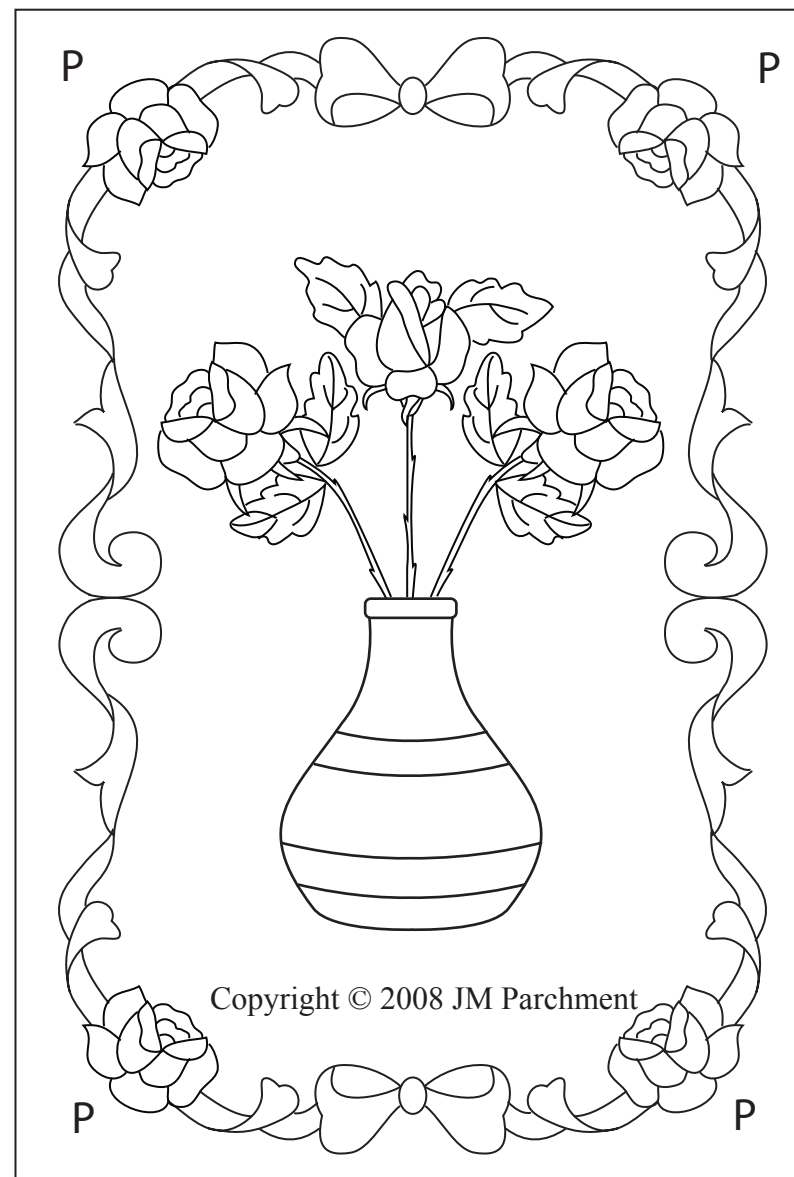
3-D Element - The Vase

On a spare piece of parchment paper trace the vase. Using a fine grid and single needle tool perforate in every hole where shown as 'P' on the pattern. Stipple the areas marked 'S' where shown. Perforate around the edge using a Mini Stamp edge tool or a twin needle tool and scissors to snip between the perforations. Attach the vase using foam pads or silicone glue.

FINISHING:

Fold to form front of card, attach an insert and cut straight around the 3 edges.

Remember these are only guidelines feel free to decorate and colour as you like.
