

NOEL— November 2008 Freebie Design

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TRACE:

Attach parchment to pattern using low tack tape and trace the design using white ink or pencil. Trace the letter squares on a spare piece of parchment.

GRID WORK

Using a single needle tool and Fine straight Grid, perforate the grid work as shown in the pattern. If you use a Bold grid you will need to adjust the number of repeats.

EMBOSS:

Micro Ball tool = Emboss around the boarder lines and each of the letter squares and the ones traced on the spare parchment. Emboss a small dot in each of the embossed sun tools.

Small Sun Tool = Emboss in the grid work as shown in the pattern.

Scriber = stipple each of the letters you traced out on the spare parchment.

PERFORATE:

Use a mini stamp edge tool or twin need tool to perforate inside each of the 4 squares where the letters will hang.

FINISHING:

Snip between perforations as shown in the grid work pattern and each of the letter squares on the main pattern to remove waste in the areas marked as 'Cut out'.

Perforate around the edge using 7 needle Fine Corner and a 3 needle Fine Corner within that. Snip between the perforations to remove the waste.

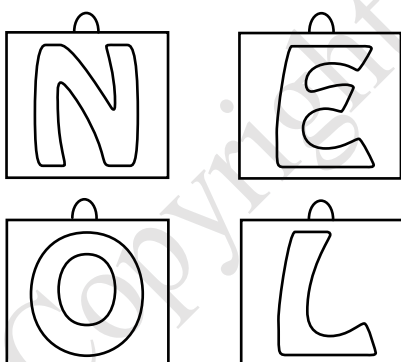
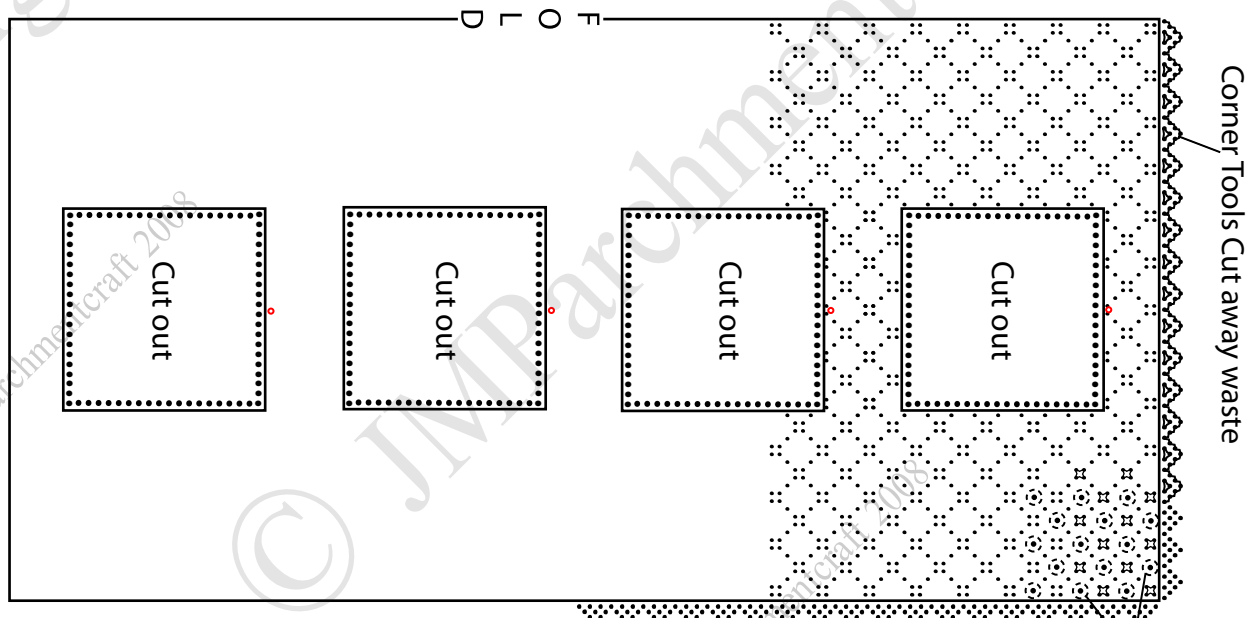
Fold parchment to form card attach an insert then cut straight around all 3 sides of the insert keeping it slightly larger than the edge of the front parchment. Use a Jump Ring to dangle each of the letters from the red dots marked on the pattern

Note: If you have no Jump Rings try using sparkly thread instead.

Remember these are only guidelines feel free to decorate and colour as you like.
