

# Heart Card

Attach parchment to pattern using low tack tape.

## TRACE:

Trace the outside rectangle in white pencil. Trace the rest of the design in gold ink. Trace the 3-D Bow on a spare piece of parchment in gold ink.

## GRID:

Use a single needle and fine grid to perforate the grid area as shown on the pattern. In the area marked 'P' perforate in every hole.

## EMBOSS:

Scriber = stipple the areas shown as 'S' on the pattern and also draw hearts in the grid work where shown. Small Ball tool = the dots in the grid work and emboss the hearts in between the ribbon slots

Mini Shader = emboss the 3-D Bow.

Micro Sun Tool = within the grid work where shown on the pattern.

## FINISHING:

Perforate around the areas shown as 'C' on the pattern and the 3-D Bow using Twin needle or a Mini Stamp Edge cutter. If using Twin needle tool snip between perforations to remove waste.

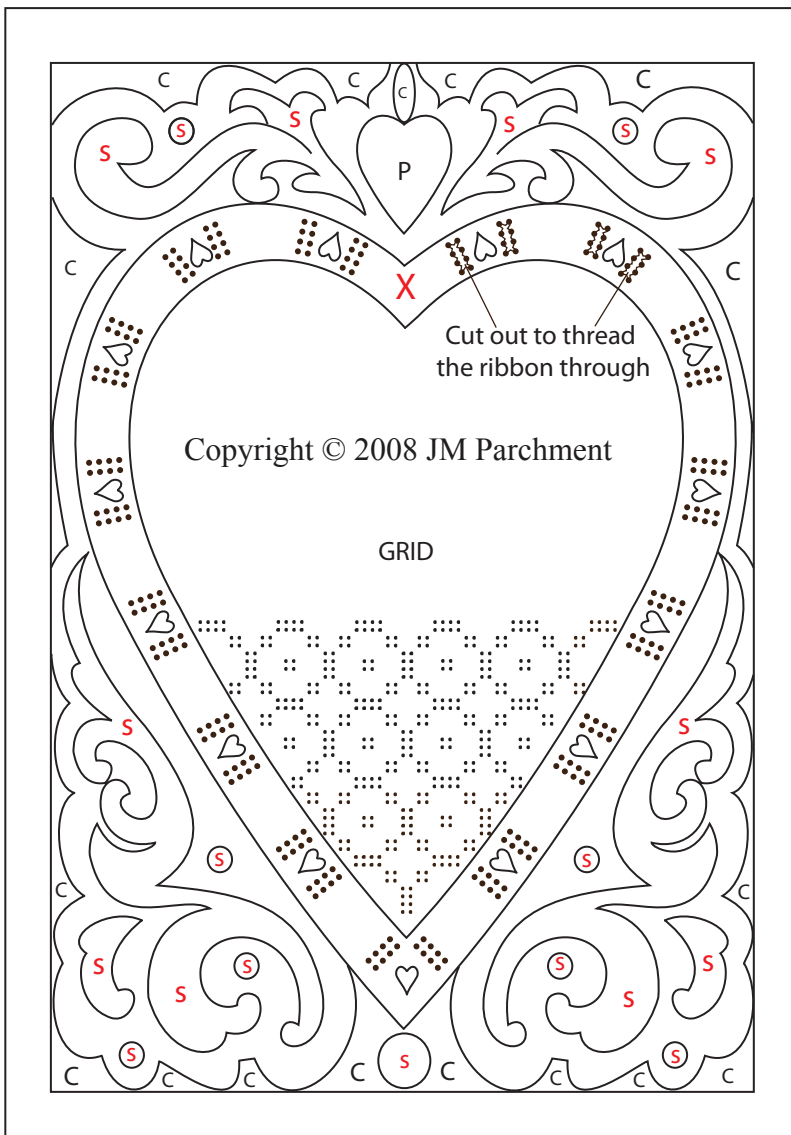
Fold parchment to form card then attach an insert.

Remember these are only guidelines feel free to decorate and colour as you like.

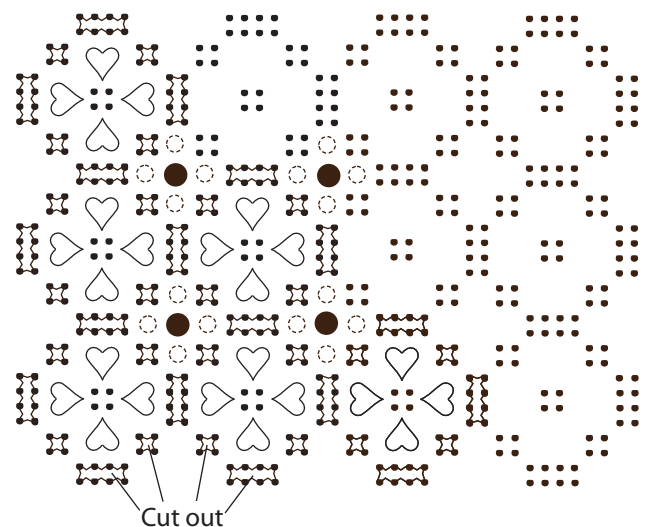
