

J & M PARCHMENT

Heart Grid and Cutout Card

This is a very basic pattern that I am only giving you guidance with as I think it is a wonderful pattern to let you loose to do what wish in each section.

Firstly attach parchment to pattern using low tack tape.

TRACE:

Trace the design in White pencil or ink, and the word 'Love' in black ink or fine liner.

EMBOSS:

Micro Ball Tool = Re-trace over all traced outlines.

Scriber = Use this tool for the stippling sections if you wish.

Selection of embossing and sun tools = Use as you wish to fill any sections.

PERFORATE:

I have used a single needle and Perforated every hole on a fine grid in the sections marked 'G' and the areas marked 'P' I have filled with various grid designs, so have fun and fill or even colour each area as you wish.

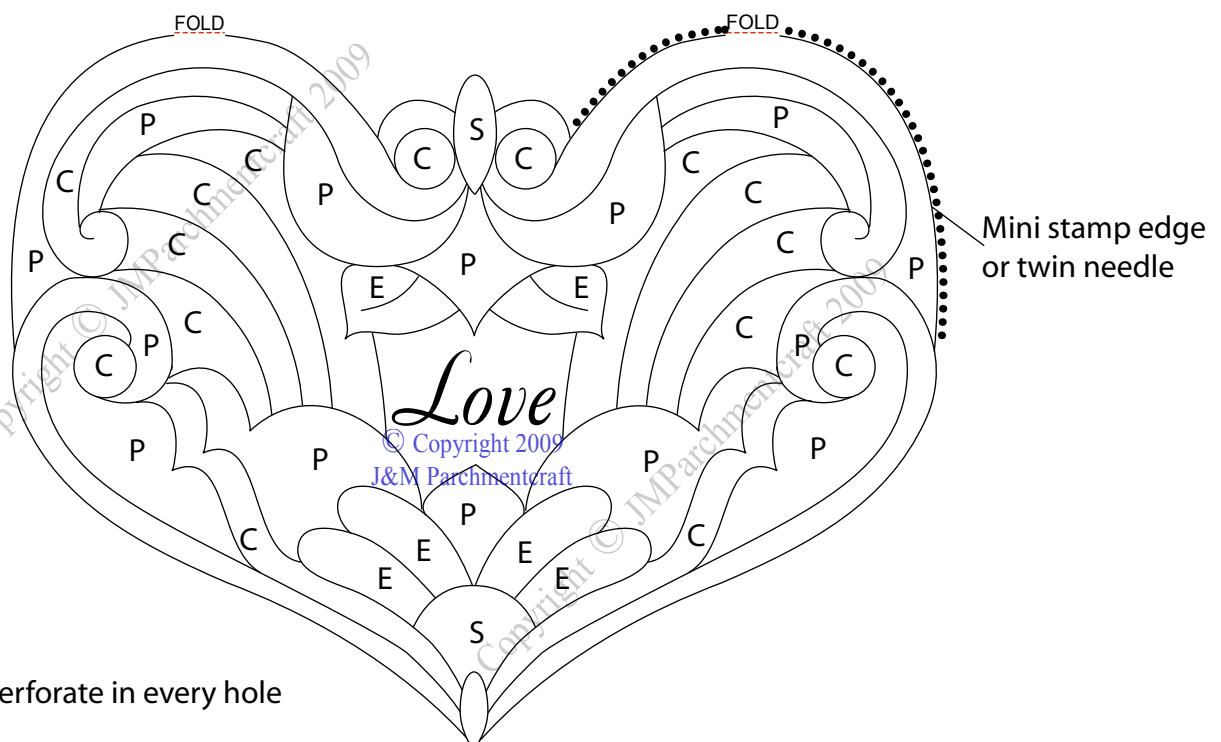
Finally use a mini stamp edge or Twin needle tool to perforate around the outer edge, use snips or scissors to remove waste is you use a twin needle tool.

ASSEMBLY:

Fold the parchment to form a card, add an insert and cut around the 3 sides of the card straight.

Remember these are only guidelines feel free to decorate and colour as you like.
