

Rose Cutout Thank You Card - by JMPARCHMENTCRAFT

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Attach parchment to pattern using low tack tape.

TRACE:

Trace the main design in White pencil or ink, leaving the cross Hatching lines out.

EMBOSS:

Micro Ball Tool = Re-trace over all traced outlines including the central wording

Scriber = Then using a ruler and scriber draw in the cross hatching lines using the marking on the ruler as a guide to spacing out the lines. *If you have no markings on the ruler then use the pattern as a guide.*

Medium Sun Tool = Emboss a sun tool as shown on the cross hatching.

PERFORATE:

Perforate using a quad or 4 needle tool in the centre of each sun tool embossed on the cross hatching.

Perforate inside each of the rose petals where shown as 'C' on the pattern using a mini stamp edge tool or twin needle tool, if using a twin needle tool then use scissors to remove the waste.

Perforate around the 3 sides of the card using a mini stamp edge or twin needle tool, if using a twin needle tool then use scissors to remove the waste.

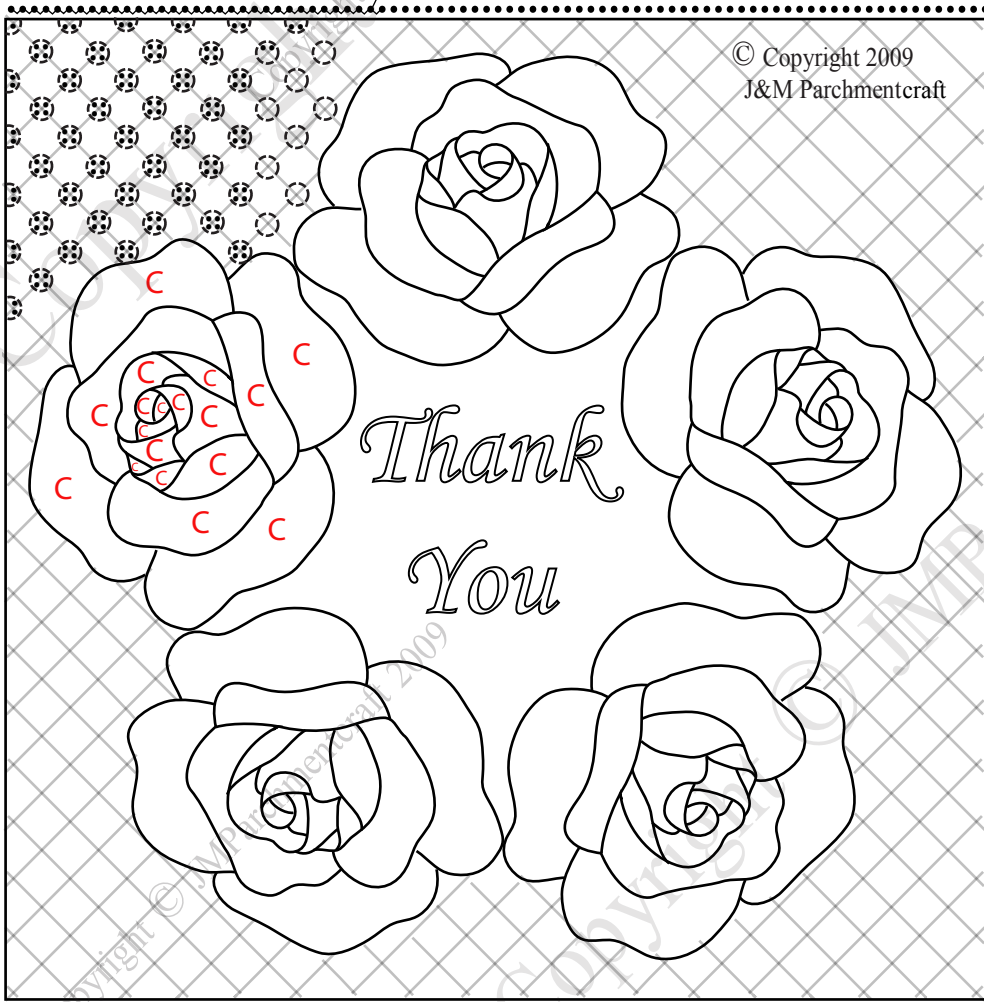
ASSEMBLY:

Fold the parchment to form a card, add an insert and cut around the 3 sides of the card straight .

Remember these are only guidelines feel free to decorate and colour as you like.
