

Happy Birthday Daisy Card

Attach parchment to pattern using low tack tape.

TRACE:

Trace the Leaves in the corner on Green ink or fine liner. Trace the Daisy flowers and the rest of the design in white pencil or ink.

COLOUR:

I have used Pintura Paints for the daisies and leaves but you can use any medium that you feel happy with.

EMBOSS:

Micro Ball tool = Trace over all white outlines you have traced. Emboss the dip dots in the centre of the daisies and a small dot inside each of the sun Tools

Mini Shader = Emboss the daisy flower petals.

Small Sun Tool = Within the cross hatching where shown on the pattern.

Micro Sun Tool = In the centre of each of the daisies.

FINISHING:

Perforate around the edge of the daisies as shown using Twin needle or a Mini Stamp Edge cutter. If using Twin needle tool snip between perforations to remove waste. Use a Quad or single needle tool to perforate on the cross hatching lines as shown on the pattern

Fold parchment to form card then attach an insert.

Remember these are only guidelines feel free to decorate and colour as you like.
